



CAD Decor – II level

a detailed program of a 1-day extended training for CAD Decor*

1. Drawing 2D shapes using various drawing tools.
2. Overview of the entity snaps (characteristic points of elements).
3. Creating simple solids with straight edges using the 'Any elements' tool (i. e. plaster-cardboard elements, concealed toilets, shelves, worktops and others).
4. Moving and copying object in 3 dimensions.
5. Insertion of interior design elements and edition of their parameters.
6. Adding 3D models to the User Database using the 'Converter 3D' tool.
7. Importing and exporting the user database of 3D models.
8. Creating your personal database of ceramic tiles.
9. General information about the visualization mode.
10. Use of the Tikkurila paints module.
11. Exchanging tiles in the project.
12. Edition of areas covered with tiles (i. e. creating niches, cutting orifices, moving tiles).
13. Arrangement of sets of tiles – how to create tiles modular systems.
14. Valuation of ceramic tiles and paints used in the project.
15. Defining the parameters of halogen lights (intensity, range, angle, style).
16. Generation of a basic visualization and saving the result as a JPG picture file.
17. Presentation of the project in a form of a 3DE animation and an AVI video.
18. Knowledge check and your own questions.

Presentation (1/2 hour before the end of the training):

1. Presentation of the Professional Rendering Module.
2. Saving an advanced visualization as a JPG file and comparing with a basic visualization.
3. Creating a 3DE animation and an AVI video using the Professional Rendering Module.
